The TVET Sector Support Programme promotes an active partnership between technical education and vocational training (TVET) institutes and private sector for imparting industry demanddriven training. The workplace-based training approach provides trained human resource to the employers according to their need, thus, increasing the chances of employments of graduates. The involved enterprises and business industry associations are engaged in selecting relevant qualifications, planning and delivering training, and conducting assessments within the national qualification framework of Pakistan.

The Programme provides technical support to training institutes and enterprises to link theoretical with practical training at the workplace. In this regard, both sides can agree on flexible approaches in training delivery, which meet the demands of the involved enterprises.

OBJECTIVE

The project was implemented by Network of Organizations Working for People with Disabilities (NOWPDP) in Karachi. This project created provision of demand-driven skills to 150 trainees (30 women and 120 men) in collaboration with the partnering enterprises. The project supported training opportunities to the persons with disabilities for better socioeconomic settling after training. It also strengthened the engagement of private sector organizations so that the engagement of enterprises in training design, coordination and delivery is enhanced.


