









The project is implemented by Karachi Institute of Culinary Arts Foundation (KICAF) in Karachi. The primary aim of the project promoted by the grant is provision and introduction of workplace-based training in Sindh. This overall objective is defined by the following benchmarks:

- Introduction of workplace-based training approach in selected national vocational qualifications:
- Strengthen the engagement of private sector organization, thus the engagement of enterprises in training design, coordination and delivery is enhanced;
- Provision of demand-driven skills to 220 women and 180 men, in collaboration with the partnering enterprises, and explore & facilitate them with the employment (selfemployment included) opportunities;



The TVET Sector Support Programme promotes an active partnership between training (TVET) institutes and private sector for imparting industry demand-driven training. The workplace-based training approach provides trained human resource to the employers according to their need, thus, increasing the chances of employments of graduates. The involved enterprises and business industry associations are engaged in selecting relevant qualifications, planning and delivering training, and conducting assessments framework of Pakistan.

The Programme provides technical support to training institutes and enterprises to link theoretical with practical training at the workplace. In this regard, both sides can agree on flexible approaches in training delivery, which meet the demands of the involved enterprises.
