The workplace-based training approach provides trained human resource to the employers according to their need, thus, increasing the chances of employments of graduates. The involved enterprises and business industry associations are engaged in selecting relevant qualifications, planning and delivering training, and conducting assessments within the national qualification framework of Pakistan.

The Programme provides technical support to training institutes and enterprises to link theoretical with practical training at the workplace. In this regard, both sides can agree on flexible approaches in training delivery, which meet the demands of the involved enterprises.

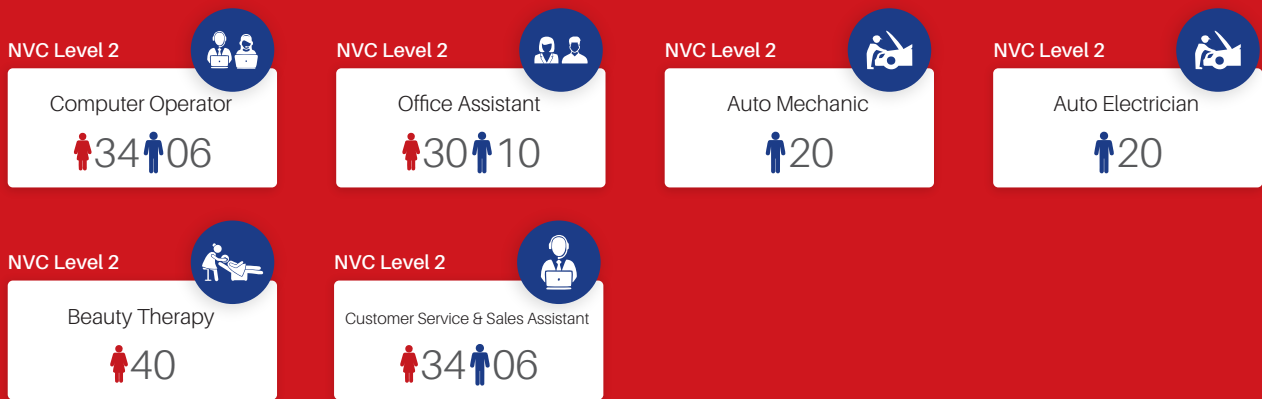
EXPANDING ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

OBJECTIVES

- To introduce workplace-based training approaches in selected national vocational qualifications;
- To strengthen the engagement of private sector organization, thus the engagement of enterprises in training design, coordination and delivery is enhanced;
- 1st Agreement
 - To ensure provision of demand-driven skills to 200 trainees (80 women and 120 men), in collaboration with the partnering enterprises, and explore & facilitate them with the employment (self-employment included) opportunities;
- Supplement
 - To impart workplace-based training to 460 trainees (70 women and 390 men) jointly with the partnering enterprises leading to employment of up to 75% graduates;
